The Internet (2006-09-11)

Along with v4 of the [findaschool.org](http://www.findaschool.org) portal, General Education Online continues to devote resources to maintaining the information contained on the website, recently adding several new trainees to help with addition requests and to assist with various non-development related upkeep.

Since 1995, I have personally committed time, money, and resources to General Education Online. I am reiterating my commitment to continue doing so in the years to come.
